2. USES

1. To talk about possessions and family relationships.

(Para posesiones y relaciones familiares)

I have got a smart phone. Tengo un móvil inteligente.
She has got a new bike. Ella tiene una bici nueva.
You have got two sisters. Tú tienes dos hermanas.
I have got one brother. Tengo un hermano.

2. To describe appearance. (Para describir la apariencia física)

Julia has got dark hair.

Peter has got green eyes.

I've got blue eyes.

Julia tiene el pelo oscuro.

Pedro tiene los ojos verdes.

Tengo los ojos azules.

3. To talk about some illnesses. (Para hablar de algunas enfermedades)

I've got a headache. Tengo dolor de cabeza.

I haven't got a headache anymore.

Ya no tengo dolor de cabeza.

She's got a stomachache.

He's got a toothache.

I've got a cold.

I've got the flu.

Ella tiene dolor de barriga.
