NEGATIVE	subject + hadn´t + past participle + compl.
INTERROGATIVE	Had+subject + past participle + compl.?
SHORT ANSWER	Yes, subject (pr.) + had
	No, subject (pr.) + hadn´t

c USES

1. ACTION IN THE PAST PREVIOUS TO ANOTHER PAST ACTION

Past Perfect and Past Simple used together (PP + PS)

- -Tony knew Istanbul so well because he had visited the city several times.
- I did not have any money because I had lost my wallet.
- -I was really fired because I had gone to bed late the night before.
- -She had waited for a long time before they came.
- By the time Alex finished, his friends had already gone away.
- -We had had that car for ten years / since 1990.
- -My father hadn't had lunch yet.
- Kristine had never been to an opera before.
- Had Susan ever studied Thai before she moved to Thailand?
