 → Susan asked me if they had flown to Norway the previous day.
- 5. The doctor asked: "Is there anything in your past that you regret?"
 - \rightarrow The doctor asked if there was anything in my past that I regretted.
- 6. BBC News reported: "The government will release all the UFO files that have been secret over the past 50 years". → BBC News reported (that) the government would release all the UFO files that had been secret over the last 50 years.
- 7. Experts advised us: "Don't open any emails from unknown senders".
 - \rightarrow Experts advised us not to open any emails from unknown senders.
- 8. "You should buy these shoes because they fit you perfectly", she advised me.
 → She advised me (that) I should buy those shoes because they fitted me perfectly.
- 9. The doctor said: "Don't take another pill until tomorrow".
 - ightarrow The doctor told me not to take another pill until the following day.
- 10. Betty asked me: "When did you arrive?"
 - \rightarrow Betty asked me when I had arrived.
- 11. The journalist asked: "Do you think scientists will decipher the mental map?"
 - ightarrow The journalist asked if we thought scientists would decipher the mental map.
- 12. The man asked me: "How can I get to the airport?"
 - ightarrow The man asked how he could get to the airport.
- 13. "Can Africa be saved?", the journalist asked.
 - \rightarrow The journalist asked if Africa could be saved.
- 14. The doctor said to the old lady: "I will not operate on you".
 - \rightarrow The doctor told the old lady (that) he/she would not operate on her.
- 15. The journalist asked: "Will global warming create more superstorms?"
 - \rightarrow The journalist asked if global warming would create more superstorms.
- 16. "Don't put sticky things in your pockets", said his mother.
 - \rightarrow His mother told him not to put sticky things in his pockets.
- 17. She told me: "I will lend you my doll next week".
 - \rightarrow She told me (that) she would lend me her doll the following week.
- 18. "Will hurricane Katrina be a warning for politicians?", asked the scientist.
- ightarrow The scientist asked if hurricane Katrina would be a warning for politicians.
- 19. Mary said to Ellen: "Don't ever marry again".
 - \rightarrow Mary told/warned Ellen not to marry ever again.
- 20. "I am very sorry for what I have done", he said.
 - ightarrow He said (that) he was very sorry for what he had done.
